Permanent Mission of India (PMI)

The PMI is the diplomatic mission and is the formal title of the Indian delegation to the United Nation, New York which is headed by a Permanent Representative.

India was among the founding members of the United Nations and signed the Declaration by United Nations on 1st January 1942.





Commission on the Status of Women (CSW)

The CSW is the principal global intergovernmental body exclusively dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women. In 2021, based on previous years' ECOSOC resolutions, CSW65 is prioritizing

"Women's full and effective participation and decision-making in public life, as well as the elimination of violence, for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls."

AIWEFA has been focusing on this theme and working for women's empowerment for several decades, and is among 5451 NGOs in active consultative status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).

EVENT BACKGROUND
